STUDENT REPORTS AND 3-WAY CONFERENCE - TOMORROW

A friendly reminder that we will be holding our 3-Way Conference tomorrow, **Friday July 22nd**. Teachers and children look forward to sharing the progress of your children in Semester 1. It is an important opportunity to acknowledge strengths and also look at what we (teachers, parent/carer and children) can do together to ensure learning gains continue in the second half of the school year. Allocated times were distributed with student reports.

Children will only attend school for the designated interview time on this day.
We ask that everyone aged 8 and Up wear a mask when inside school buildings.

TERM 3 COVID UPDATE

As you would be aware, following advice from the Acting Chief Health Officer, the Victorian Government recently announced changes to the pandemic orders:

- It is an expectation that anyone aged 8 and above is wearing a mask when inside school buildings.
- Parents and carers who have COVID-19 can transport their non-COVID-19 children via private vehicle to their primary or secondary school when an alternative person is not available to assist. The parent or carer must travel directly to and from the school only.
- Family members are asked to continue reporting positive COVID-19 cases to both the [Department of Health](#) and our own [testing portal](#).
- You must also let the school know if your child is a close contact. Students who are close contacts and want to attend should still take 5 RATs over 7 days and wear a face mask whilst indoors if they are aged 8 years or over.

Students should continue to stay home if they are unwell, even if they test negative on a RAT.
Thank you for your support as we continue to make these adjustments.

EARLY HELP FAMILY SERVICES

We are extremely fortunate to have Tessa joining the CGPS community to support families under the umbrella of the Early Help Family Services, connected with Anglicare.

Hello,

My name is Tessa Ballard. I work for Anglicare Victoria in Bendigo and my role is the Early Help Family Services Practitioner. I have over 8 years combined experience in working with children and families in the welfare sector, as well as in Early Childhood education and care services.



I will provide family support to parents and carers who may be experiencing some challenges or difficulties and will assist them to develop a plan and strategies to address these issues. The support that I will offer is flexible and will differ depending on each individual family's situation. This may look like me coming into the home, meeting with families on site at the school or, whatever works for your family.

I will be working with your children's Educators and the well-being team at the school to help achieve positive outcomes for all. The support I can provide will be short-term (up to 10 hours with each family).

There are no silly questions, if I am not the right person my role is also to help direct and connect families with other relevant services who can provide the support that is required.

Please come and say 'Hello' if you see me at your child's service and feel like I may be able to provide support to your family! You can also discuss any queries with your school's staff/well-being team, and they will chat with me around referrals to the Early Help Program.

The Athlete Development Program (ADP) is dedicated to providing student-athletes with a specialised training and development environment, while placing equal emphasis on supporting students' academic and personal application required to reach their goals.

The ADP is select-entry and provides tailored coaching from highly skilled staff and specialist coaches.

- Select entry program (students must be participating in their chosen sport)
- Offers highly skilled staff and coaches ([ADP Coach Profiles](#))
- Shapes and supports students sporting pathways and passions
- Encourages students to find their personal best in and out of the classroom
- Prioritises high behavioural expectations and effort

All students enrolled at Bendigo South East College, Bendigo Senior Secondary College, Crusoe College, Eaglehawk Secondary College and Weeroona College Bendigo can apply.

Students can be selected to the ADP to participate in AFL, Athletics (Distance & Field/Sprints), Basketball, Cricket, Football (Soccer) and Netball. Students involved in sports not listed are still eligible to apply for the program.

Expressions of interest will be collected for: Cycling (Road and Track), Mountain Biking and Volleyball.

Selection and Criteria

- Undertake physical testing and sport squad trial/s
